You will also lead the school through Ofsted inspection readiness, embedding self-evaluation and continuous improvement across all areas. Working collaboratively with governors, staff, and parents, you will cultivate a culture of aspiration, accountability, and joy in learning

 - Raise educational standards through data-informed decision-making, staff coaching, and curriculum innovation.
 - Champion high expectations and a shared vision that inspires staff, pupils, and the wider community.
 - Report regularly to the Board of Governors on progress, risks, and strategic priorities.

- Ensure the curriculum (Islamic Studies, Qur’an, Arabic, Montessori, and National Curriculum subjects) is coherent, ambitious, and inclusive.
 - Lead on teaching and learning standards, supporting CPD, mentoring, and appraisal systems.

 - Foster a culture of pedagogical excellence, innovation, and collaboration among staff.
